STEP 1: ASSESS READINESS

Community Engagement

Co-designing the mobile care partnership through community engagement approaches is a key component of assessing readiness and ensuring the project is built by and for the communities you serve. Implementation Report

Developing a Implementation Report for our partners was a pivotal first step to conceptualize a mobile care partnership. This report including the following components.

Environmental Scan

The Environmental Scan may consist of an overview of mental health and addictions in a broad context, current care models, existing mobile care services among partners, a heat map, and a gap assessment.

Partnership Readiness Assessment

The Partnership Readiness Assessment may consist of matrices outlining existing community partnerships and roles and responsibilities.

Program Design and Recommendations

Based on the aforementioned activities, the report may consist of proposed objectives, delivery model, key stakeholders, and measurement and evaluation recommendations.
